What Jesus said about Repentance

Just from the book of Matthew -

- **Matthew 4:17** — “From that time on Jesus began to preach, ‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near.’”
- **Matthew 9:13** — “For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.” (*Parallel in Mark and Luke; repentance is implied.*)
- **Matthew 11:20–21** — “Then Jesus began to denounce the towns... because they did not repent. ‘Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida!... If the miracles... had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago.’”
- **Matthew 12:41** — “The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment... for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and now something greater than Jonah is here.”

Repentance is necessary to faith. There has to be a turning away from sin and towards God.

Hebrew – “Shuv” Turn or return

Greek – “Metanoia” Change of Heart/Mind

What Jesus said about Money/Finance

Theme	Example Reference	Summary
God vs. Money	Matt. 6:24; Luke 16:13	You can't serve both masters.
Generosity	Luke 6:38; Matt. 5:42	Give freely; God provides.
Stewardship	Matt. 25:14–30; Luke 19:11–27	Be faithful with what God entrusts to you.
Danger of Greed	Luke 12:15; Mark 10:23	Wealth can choke spiritual life.
Heavenly Treasure	Matt. 6:19–21	Invest in eternal things.
Justice and Compassion	Luke 14:13–14; Matt. 23:23	Use resources to help the poor and show mercy.
Contentment and Trust	Matt. 6:25–34	Don't worry — God knows your needs.
