



The Stones will Cry out!

Luke 19:28-44



God is in the detail! (Vs 28-36)

- Fulfilled prophecy - *See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey. (Zechariah 9:9)*
- Misunderstood – A conquering King to overthrow the Romans?
- Later people called “Crucify him”
- What do we do when things don’t happen as we expect, Can we deal with disappointment?
- Jesus gives clear instructions – The disciples find it just as he said. Jesus want us to understand, he makes things clear!



The Stones will cry out! (Vs 40)



- The Pharisees want to silence Jesus. Religion can crush worship!
- Religion – A system of faith and worship. Following a pattern, duty etc.
- Worship – For the audience of one – God!
- Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. John 4:23
- Worship is from our spirit, Worship should be genuine
- Are we going through the motions or is our worship an act of love and passion?



Recognize the times (Vs 41-44)

- A prophecy of what was to come – The temple was destroyed in AD70
- There was a misunderstanding of who Jesus was a why he had come
- Are we aware of what God is doing now? Be watchful!
- Things often don't happen as we expect. Don't put God in a box!
- Difficult times come and we often misinterpret them
- Ask God – “What are you teaching me?”
